Changes



- Converted one Batch-WN to third Atlas-WGS
- Added new hardware to grid-ce3
 - Share to be adapted for .../de VOMS groups
- Some hardware awaiting installation
- Kernel upgrade: See Stephans advisory
- We want to upgrade Java to 1.6
- Last RPM changes: Try rpm -qa --last

Current problems



- "Sudden Death" of Workernodes
 - Nodes shut down without notification in log files
 - No HW failure
 - Under investigation
 - Most probable suspect: Lustre problem
- Atlas SW compilation shows bad scaling behavior
 - Under investigation with WolfgangE
 - Very first hint: underlying CMT problem

WGS occupancy



- Problem: Atlas user complaining about too much user load on WGS
- One solution: Third WGS
 - Will not scale...
- Both Atlas and operators don't want to put limits on processes on WGS
 - Instead: "Social monitoring"
- No special tools provided by operators
 - Try OS tools like top, sar, dstat, or vmstat
 - Will do a web page with this
- Not to forget: Use the batch system!
 - Do you know qrsh? (interactive shell on a batch node)
