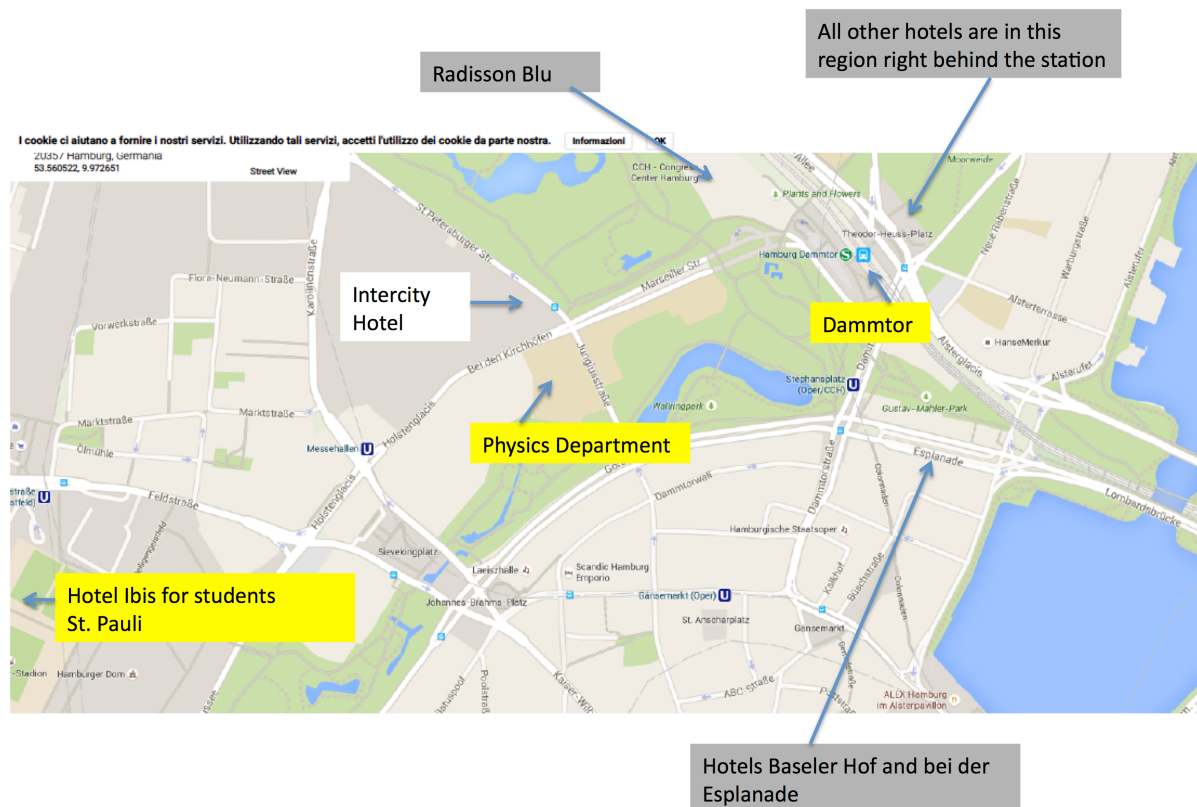
Welcome to the 3rd International Summer School on Intelligent Signal Processing for FrontIER Research and Industry in Hamburg. Please read carefully the information provided below before your arrival. We are looking forward to seeing you soon!



Reaching the Physics Department:

The school will take place in the **Department of Physics of the University of Hamburg at Jungiusstrasse 9, Hamburg**. The department is conveniently located in the centre of the town at 10 minutes walk from the Hamburg Dammtor station and 10 minutes walk from the Alster lake.

From the airport: take the S-Bahn S1 and change at Hamburg Hbf for the S11, S21 or S31 and get out at Hamburg Dammtor. It will take approximately 30-40 minutes from the airport.



Arriving by train: get out at Hamburg Dammtor. In case your train does not stop at Dammtor, get out at Hamburg Hbf and change for the S11, S21 or S31 to Dammtor. From Hamburg Dammtor, you can walk to the physics department, it will take approximately 10 minutes. Go in the direction of the Radisson Hotel and the park Planten und Blomen. Take the stairs to the hotel, pass the hotel and the congress centre (CCH) which will be on your right. Turn then on the left and take the walk under the glass roof which has the Japanese garden on your right. Walk up to the end until you arrive at a traffic light. You will find the InterCity hotel in front of you and

the physics department (a yellow brick building) on your left at the other side of the crossing. Cross the road and enter at number 9, which is in an internal court.

Arriving by car note that parking in that area is very difficult. Please contact the local organisers if you plan to come by car.

Reaching the Hotel IBIS Budget St Pauli Messe

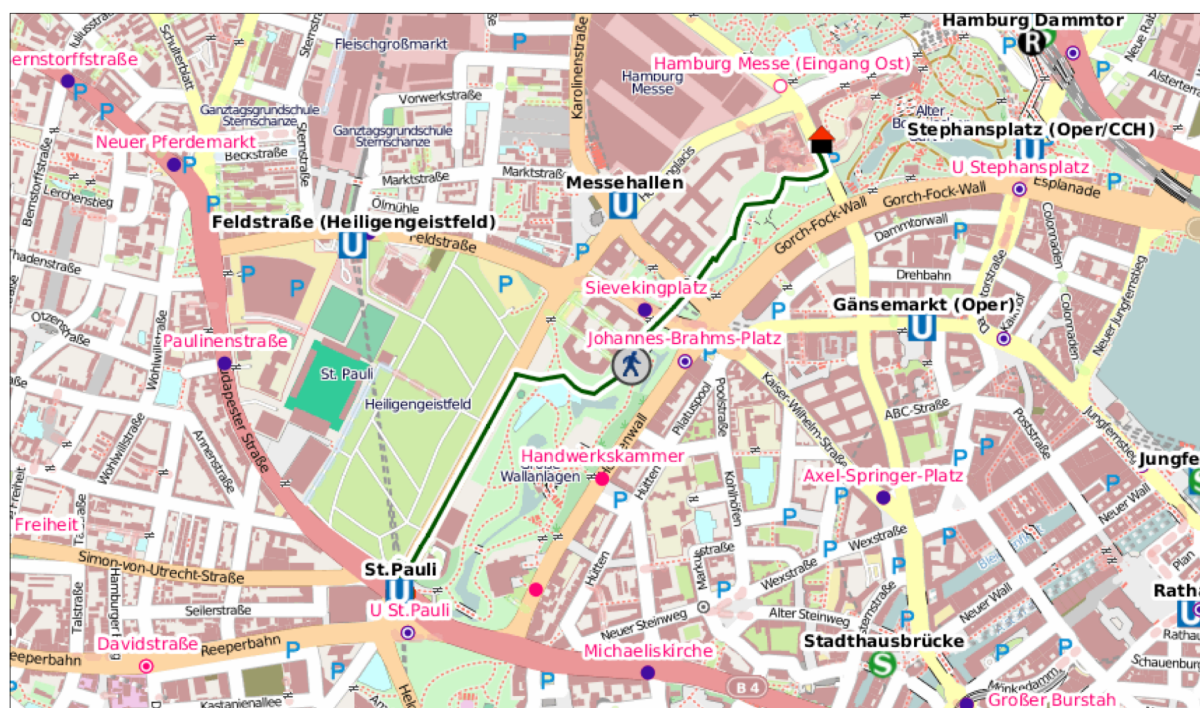
The IBIS Budget St Pauli hotel is located at **Simon-von-Utrecht Strasse 64**, 20359 Hamburg.

From the airport: take the S1 and change at Hamburg Hbf (the main station) for the U3 (direction Schlump) and get off at St Pauli. The hotel is 100 m from the St Pauli station.

From Hamburg Hbf: take the U3 to St Pauli. Arriving at the Hamburg Dammtor station, take the S11, S21 or S31 to Hamburg Hbf, then the U3 to St Pauli.

From the Physics Department: walking should take about 20 minutes (see map below). By bus, walk (10 min) to Johannes-Brahms-Platz and take bus line number 112 and get out at U St. Pauli.

Other Hotels: if you are staying in another hotel please refer to your hotel website for the directions.



Public transportation in Hamburg

All participants, who registered before 31 August, will receive at the registration desk an HVV card valid 15 days for the public transportation.

Registration

The registration desk is located at the 2nd floor of the Department of Physics, and it will be open on **14 September from 16:00 until 18:00** and on **15 September from 08:00 until 09:00**.

Payment at the registration desk is not possible! The registration fee must be paid in advance by credit card or bank transfer.

You are requested to always wear and display your name tag in the conference venue during the meeting.

Lectures

All lectures occur in the Auditorium III of the Physics Department on the 2nd floor.

Posters

All students are encouraged to bring a poster presenting her/his research work. The posters should be produced in A1 format and will be displayed in the seminar room 4 (SR4) at the 2nd floor. They can be appreciated and discussed during the coffee breaks.

Safety course

The safety course is obligatory for all participants. It will take place on **15 September at 15:30 in the Auditorium III on the 2nd floor**.

Social program

The coffee breaks during the school, the welcome cocktail, on 15 September, and the farewell drink, on 25 September are included in the registration fee and will take place in SR4.

The school dinner, which is also included in the registration fee, will take place on 23 September during a boat trip on the Elbe. A bus will take the participants from the Physics Department to the harbour at 18:00. An extra badge that must be worn during the boat trip will be given to the attendants of the dinner. **The deadline for late registration for the dinner is 17 September.**

Eating

Lunches will not be provided during the school. At the Physics Department there is a small cafeteria. On the other side of the street, at Jungiusstrasse 6, there is the canteen of the Bucerius Law School, however one needs a special card to pay, for no money is accepted. In the Dammtor train station (~10 min walk, follow the orange line on the map below) one finds coffee shops and fast-food. You will find good restaurants with convenient prices along the Colonnaden (~10 min walk, follow the red line on the map below).
