Facilities distributed the survey between 02/12 and 08/12


0 1400 responses!


- 4,6% of estimated 30.000 users → very significant
- 340 users left their email for providing future feedback



User Survey – question #1a

#1 Did you hear about the www.wayforlight.eu web portal? Type of answer: YES/NO





41 % heard about it → biased answers

wayforlight visits increased by a factor of 5 (3.000 users) since Dec 1st


Other: Colleague > Conference > ESUO > leaflet



User Survey – question #2

#2 Within the last year, how many different European facilities did you submit proposals to?

Type of answer: Choices: 0/1/2/3/>3




- 55% of users submit proposals to ≥2 different facilities/year
- 7% submit to >3 facilities/year



User Survey – question #3a

#3 How useful would you rank the following user tools

Type of answer: From 1 to 5 (Not at all/Slightly/Moderately/Very/Extremely)



Need for staggered deadlines

- 95% (70 / 74) of comments specified "not coincident"
- Important for 74%


(Moderately + Very + Extremely)

- Very + Extremely = 44%
- Not at all = 14%



User Survey – question #3b

#3 How useful would you rank the following user tools




- "Very + Extremely" important = 76,7% of responses
- the highest ranked tool
- Comments: truly useful if available at ALL facilities (ESRF?), various opinions on proposals' portability and sharing of information



User Survey – question #3c

#3 How useful would you rank the following user tools




- "Very + Extremely" important =
 64% of responses
- Umbrella would be useful if applied to ALL facilities (e.g. SOLEIL, DIAMOND)
- Warning: some confuse ID with data set including proposals' history to be shared among panelist and facilities



User Survey – question #3d


#3 How useful would you rank the following user tools



- "Very + Extremely" important = 60%, "Moderately" = 29%
- Mixed comments: some think beamline scientists should have this role, others say such forums already exist, other are much in favour

User Survey – question #3e

#3 How useful would you rank the following user tools



- "Very + Extremely" important= 62%
- Comments: single page with deadlines, issue of (not-)sharing info between facilities / panels → constructive suggestions for smart beamtime allocation
