Caution !

 *Due to construction work no regional or long-distance trains are running between the stations Charlottenburg and Alexanderplatz. For route diversions see [this link](#) (german only). S-Bahn trains are running, though.*

Meals

Coffee, tea and water is provided during the coffee breaks. Several cafés and restaurants can be found in the surrounding area. The student cafeteria “Mensa Nord” is located diagonally opposite to the building in northwest direction (marked as “HN 7” at the map). It offers a wide variety of meals (see [here](#) for the menus). Non-HU guests are required to buy a guest card from the machine in the foyer, since no cash is accepted. Note that non-Berlin students do not get reduced prices. The guest card can be loaded with a certain amount of money. After usage the remaining balance can be obtained from the same machine.

WiFi

W-LAN is available in the whole building. Network access is possible [via an HU account](#) or [Eduroam](#) for guests. For non-Eduroam users additional accounts can be provided (please contact the organizers).

ⓘ Please be warned that the connection quality of the W-LAN might be low due to the usage of the frequencies by competing WiFi networks. Try to use the 5 GHz channels and **avoid to download large files or streaming**. Those who are able to connect by LTE via a mobile device should try this.

For the lecturers a LAN connection is available.

The lecture hall contains only a few sockets. Some multiple plugs and extension cables are provided, but it surely helps if you bring your own.




Building map
