

2. Horizon 2020 - Contracts

 - Annex 2 Estimated budget for the action
 - Annex 3 Accession Forms (signatures of beneficiaries)
 - Annex 4 Model for the financial statements (Form C)
 - (Annex 5 Model for the certificate on the financial statements)
 - (Annex 6 Model for the certificate on the methodology (not applicable))

- Consortium Agreement: contract between all 19 beneficiaries to manage the consortium



Horizon 2020 - General Rules


- > Communication towards EC only via Coordinator
- > Financing: 100% direct real costs &
25% indirect costs/overheads
- > Reporting: towards EC every 18 months



3. Information on Reporting (Art 20 GA)

EC Reporting


- > All reports to the European Commission are submitted via the Coordinator
 - Periodic reports including financial statements → **every 18 months**
 - Final report (end of project)
 - Mid-Term review? *interview in Brussels*
- > Reports must be submitted within 60 days after the end of each reporting period
content: scientific & financial part
- > Deliverables to be submitted in time



Additional

- > Interim reports are requested by the Coordinator for successful project management → **every 6 months**

5. Financial Reporting

WHAT to be submitted to the coordinator?

1. Interim Report by all 19 beneficiaries (every 6 months)
 - Excel based template containing costs and short explanations
 - Final Template yet to be determined will be send to you

2. Periodic Report (every 18 months) with
 - Individual financial statement (Annex 4 of GA) and
 - Explanation of the use of resources
 - Done electronically in Participant Portal (PP) only
 - Filled out by each beneficiary (individually)
 - Signed (by Financial Statement Authorized Signatory (FSIGN)) and
 - Formally submitted to the coordinator (via the PP)

Financial Reporting

WHEN to be submitted to the coordinator?

DEADLINE FOR YOUR REPORTS to the coordinator:

Interim Report 1: 28.02.2016

Interim Report 2: 31.08.2016

Periodic Financial Report 1: 28.02.2017 + *30 days* = *31.03.2017*

Interim Report 3: *TBA*

Periodic Financial Report 2: 31.08.2018 + *30 days* = *30.09.2018*

Final Financial Report is generated automatically




6. General Information

GA 32.1 - The European Charter for Researchers shall be considered employing personnel

- career development.



Art 39.2 GA – Processing of Personal Data

*“The beneficiaries must inform the personnel whose personal data are collected and processed by the Commission. For this purpose, they must provide them with the **service specific privacy statements (SSPS)** [...], before transmitting their data to the Commission.”*
