
Computing Week (Oct 13th to 17th)

- User analysis in a distributed environment
 - Quite a hot topic and active field
 - Where to run skim jobs (T1 or T2)?
 Centrally managed or by working group
 - New Analysis Support Task Force in setup
 - New PAT version (2.0) almost ready
- Tier-2 round table
 - Common contribution by FZK related Tier-2 (ChW & Th.Kress)
 - Aachen, DESY, CSCS (Manno, Swiss), Warsaw (Poland)
 - Communication between Tier-2 sites and physics groups?
 - Storage management is the biggest concern (From site and physics perspective)
 - Many technical issues to be solved

- Rather stable running
 - Good usage by CMS
 - Analysis & MC



- New hardware in commissioning
 - Steady ramp-up
 - Storage and CPU
- MoA credits for Tier-2
 - Recently reviewed by CRB
 - 0.4 per site and 0.4 per hosted group
 - 3.2 for Germany (2 sites, 6 groups hosted)
 - Distribution to be done inside Germany



CMSSW Deployment

- All CMS production sites get CMSSW releases centrally
 - 15 sites in OSG (US + Brazil)
 - About 40 sites in EGEE region (Europe + Asia)
 - Responsible for EGEE installations: ChW & Brussels team
- ◆ No major problems (Even during 3 weeks of holidays)
 - Releases typically available 24h after release
- Person power situation improved
 - Two new members from Belgium joined
 - Actual work basically done in "shifts" per week
