DESY Requirements for Passwords to be accepted

Minimum length **eight** characters ¹

No use of words from dictionaries

Use of characters out of at least three of the following four categories

- Upper case letters
- Lower case letters
- Numbers
- Special characters ²

No use of

- own first names
- own last names
- own **account name** (userid)
- special names ³

¹ maximal 14 characters

² special characters: ! # \$ % & ' () * + , - . / : ; < = > ? @ [] ^ _ ` { | } ~
not allowed characters: " \ blank umlaut and ctrl-character

³ special names are e.g.: desy, doris, petra, hera, tesla etc.

- > The Belle II members list / member database is currently maintained at KEK
- > It is based on a rather simple database technology
- > At DESY an Identity and Access Management system (IAM) is under development as part of the DESY IT infrastructure
- > If the database model is defined, the IAM might offer a good solution
- > The contents could be maintained from abroad (KEK)
