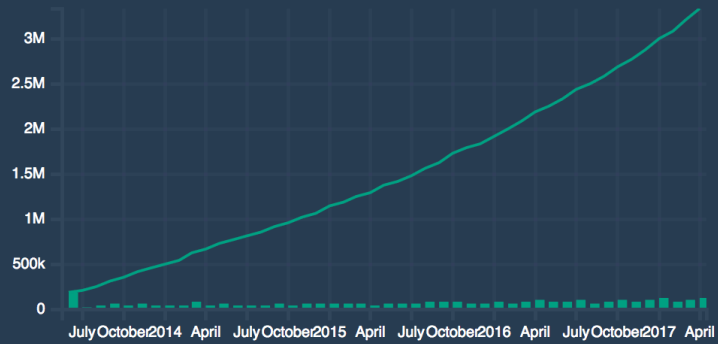

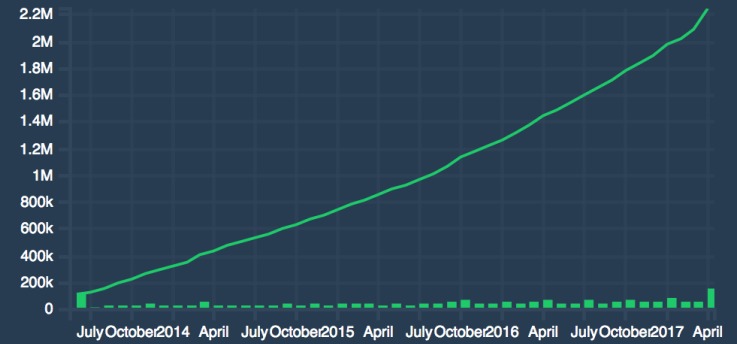

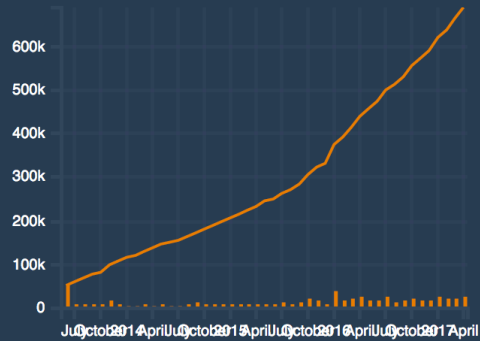
## live orcid ids over time



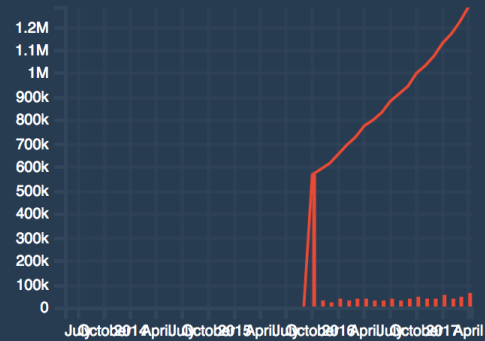

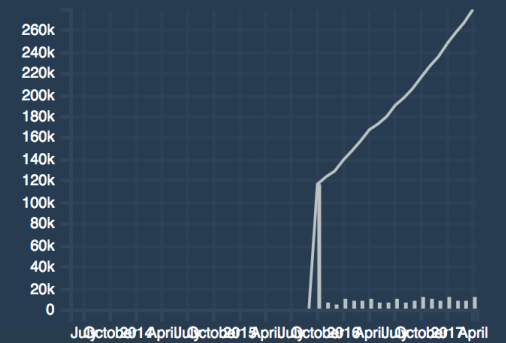

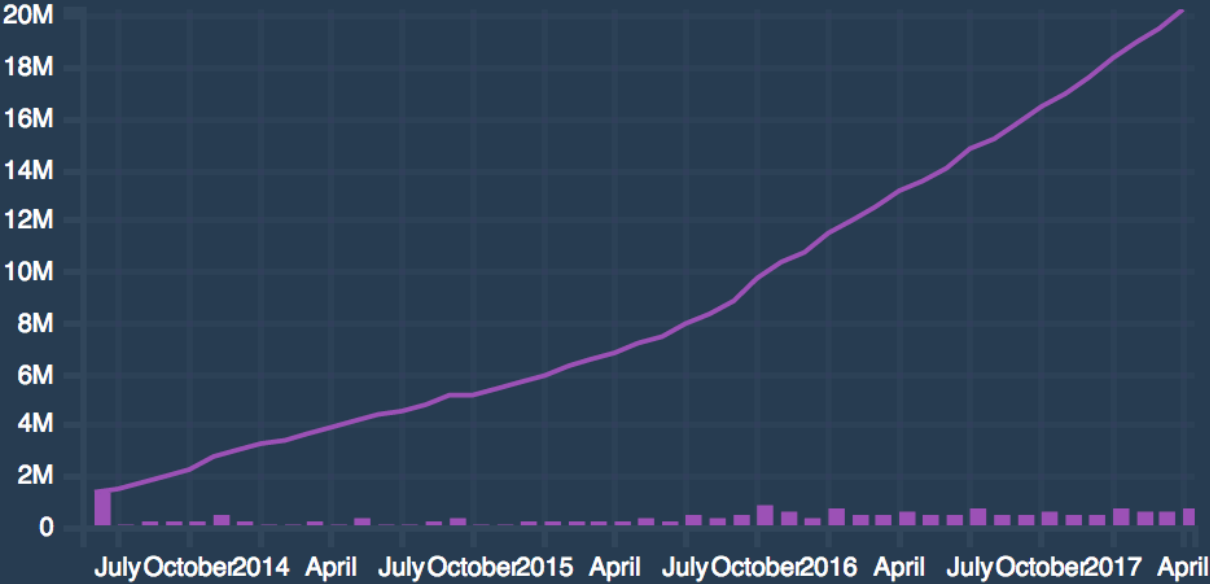

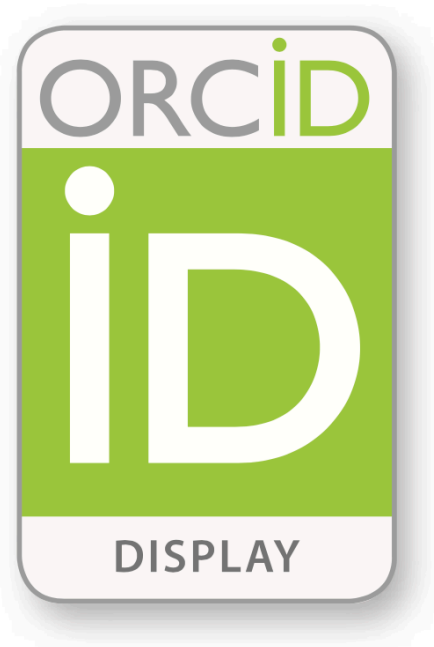


# works in orcid by month

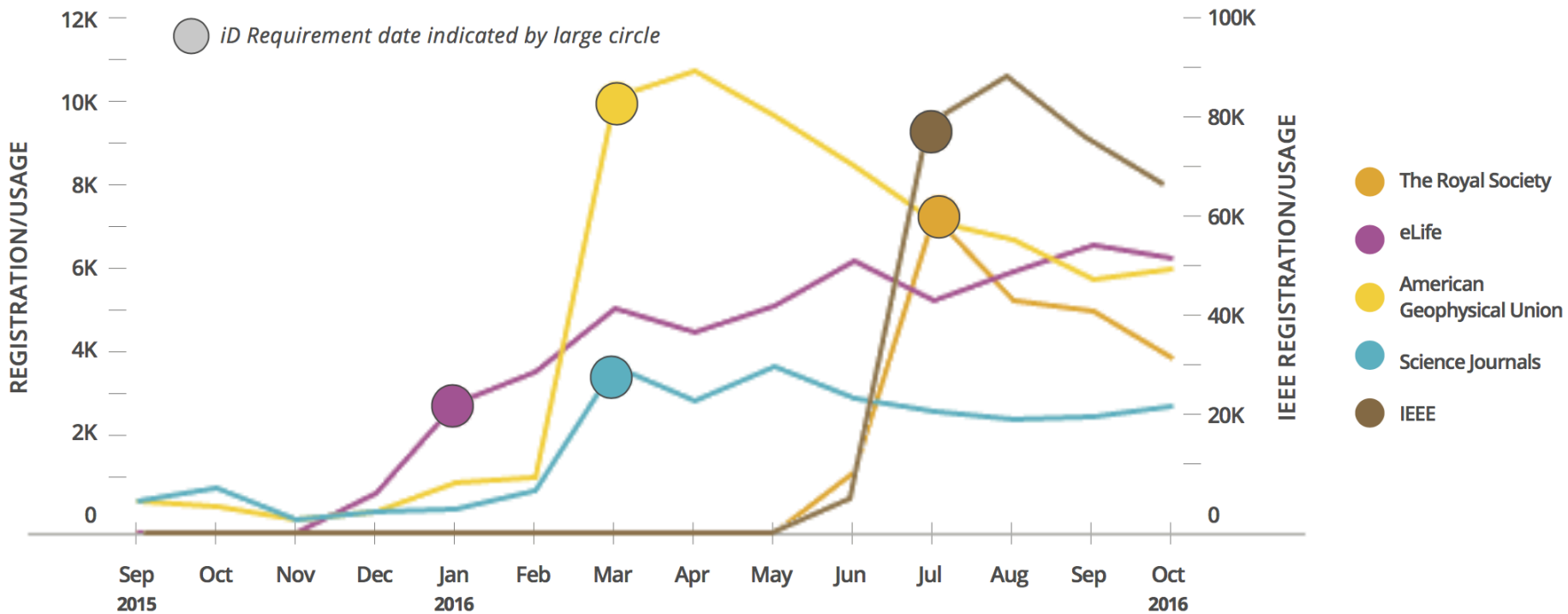

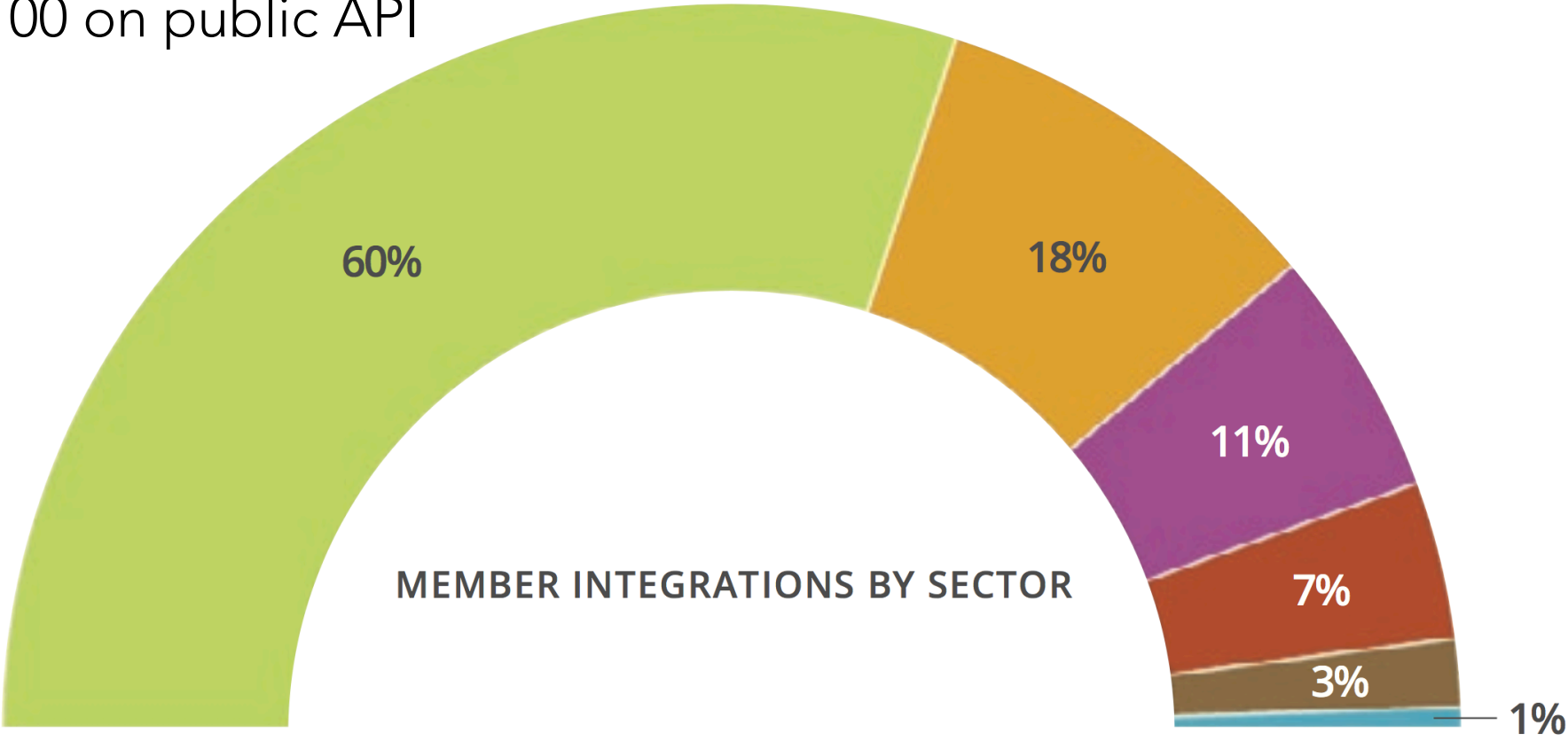
