
#### **General remarks**

- > Running was smooth, no major problems
- > Since last "full NUC" was beginning February:
- > Some words about the shutdown 17.2.09 (switch replacement):
  - Took longer than expected: Unforeseen problems with the new switch, understood
  - SE upgraded: ILC/Calice simple update, CMS and Atlas upgrade to latest dCache version (1.9.x with Chimera)
- Selected issues: See later

> Problems arriving at naf-helpdesk, and fraction passed to the second-level support:




#### Some issues

- > Problem: ssh-connection is lost after 1-2 days
  - Waiting for input of concerned user
  - Is this a common problem?
- Problem: Transfer rate to Freiburg
  - Rate from NAF is similar as rate from non-NAF DESY(-HH) computers
  - Better rate (CERN-Freiburg) and (UniKA-Freiburg)
  - Our network experts need contact person in Freiburg to investigate further (to run e.g. iperf and other tools)
- /tmp and /scratch running full
  - Check scripts are ready
  - Installation and configuration details still need to be sorted at, therefore not yet working
- New Lustre instance in Zeuthen: Still in testing phase (e.g. because of quota support)



### **Proxy renewal**

- Problem: Login-proxy not available in NAF
  - But is needed for e.g. data access
- Idea: Automatic proxy renewal using MyProxy and Kerberos authz
