## **5th Anniversary of SL**

- Officially launched at HEPiX Spring 2004 in Edinborough
- SL 5.3 released in March 2009 for i386 and x86\_64
  - SL 5.4 expected for October 2009
- SL 4.8 underway, currently in build phase
  - Release expected for July 2009
- > SL6 under investigation
  - Logo contest has been opened
  - Release expected for January 2010
- Continued delivery of security updates
  - Errata for SL 3.0.9, all 4.x, all 5.x
  - Fastbugs only for latest 4.x, 5.x
- More in Troy Dawson's Presentation at Spring 2009 HEPiX in Umeå, Sweden

## SL 4.x Roadmap

- > Current support commitment ends October 2010
- RedHat's last update expected Q4 2009
  - Will become SL 4.9

#### Proposal made at Umeå

- > Make 4.9 the "legacy" release in October 2010
- > End support for all older SL4 at that time
- Support SL 4.9 until February 2012

- > Grid farms are supposed to migrate to SL5-64 this summer

- > alpine replaces pine (since 5.1)
  - Successor of pine, which is no longer supported
- > lpw3945 (community addition)
  - Firmware, kernel module and daemon for recent Intel WiFi cards
- > fftw (community addition in 5.3)
  - C-subroutine library for multi-dimensional Discrete Fourier Transforms
- > scipy (community addition in 5.3)
  - Numerical routines for integration and optimization
- > **suitesparse** (community addition in 5.3)
  - Libraries for computations involving sparse matrices

Most of these are optional and not installed by default. See release notes on scientificlinux.org for complete listing of packages. Let us know what you need.



### **Issues With SL 5.x**

- > Telekom Root Certificates in Firefox 3 almost solved after two years
  - See https://bugzilla.mozilla.org/show\_bug.cgi?id=378882, quote:

------ Comment #130 From Kathleen Wilson 2009-04-06 15:26:47 PDT ------[...] Based on this assessment I recommend that Mozilla approve the request to add the Deutsche Telekom Root CA 2 root certificate to NSS and enable all three trust bits.

- > Firefox3 behaviour with AFS (database files) and Printing
- > Applications expect CUPS print service
  - We are providing one
