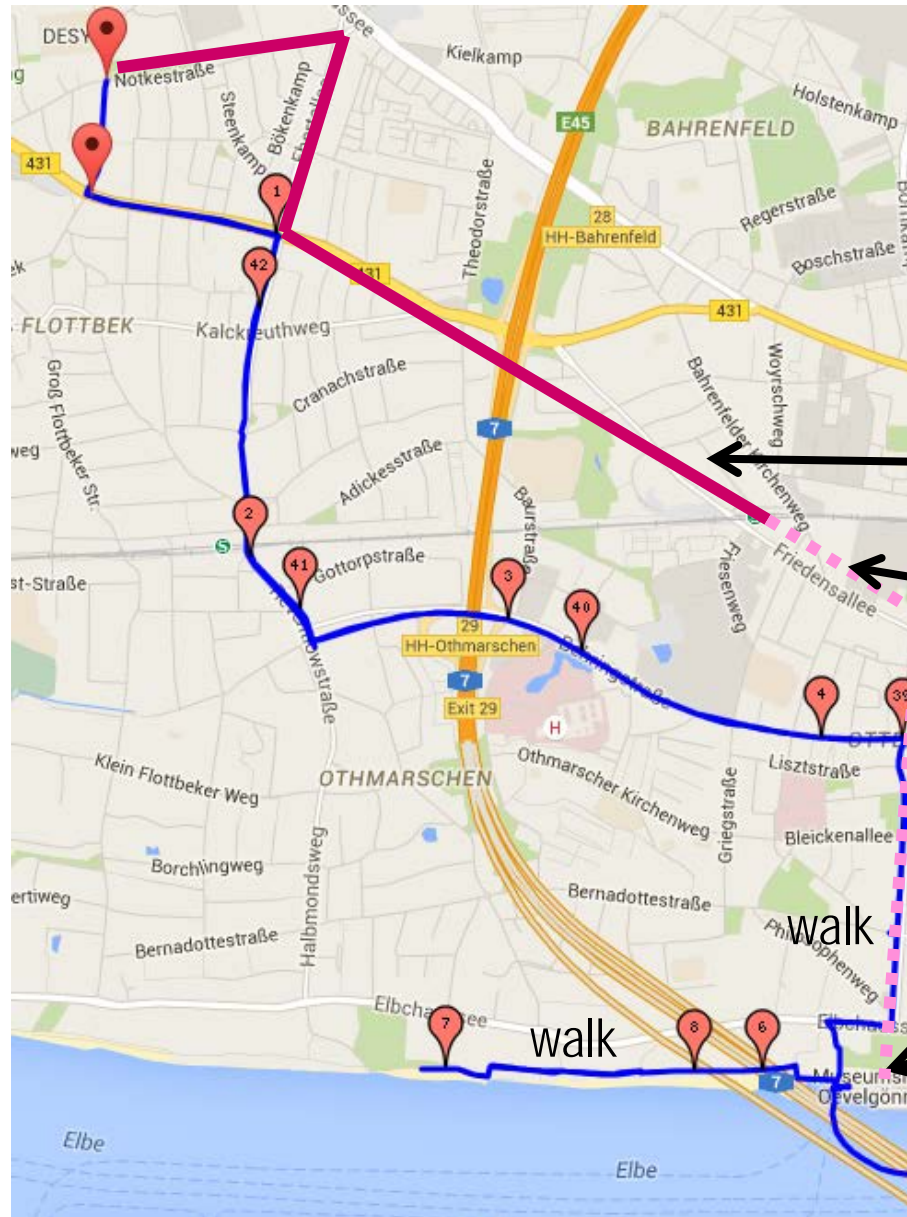


Hamburg Touristic Marathon, total distance ~42.195 km

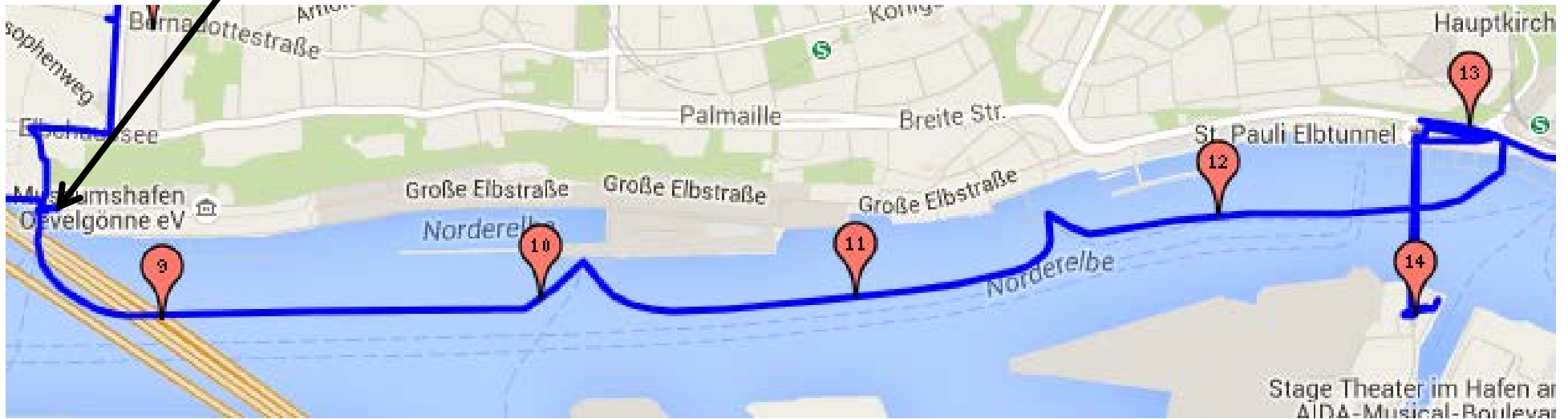

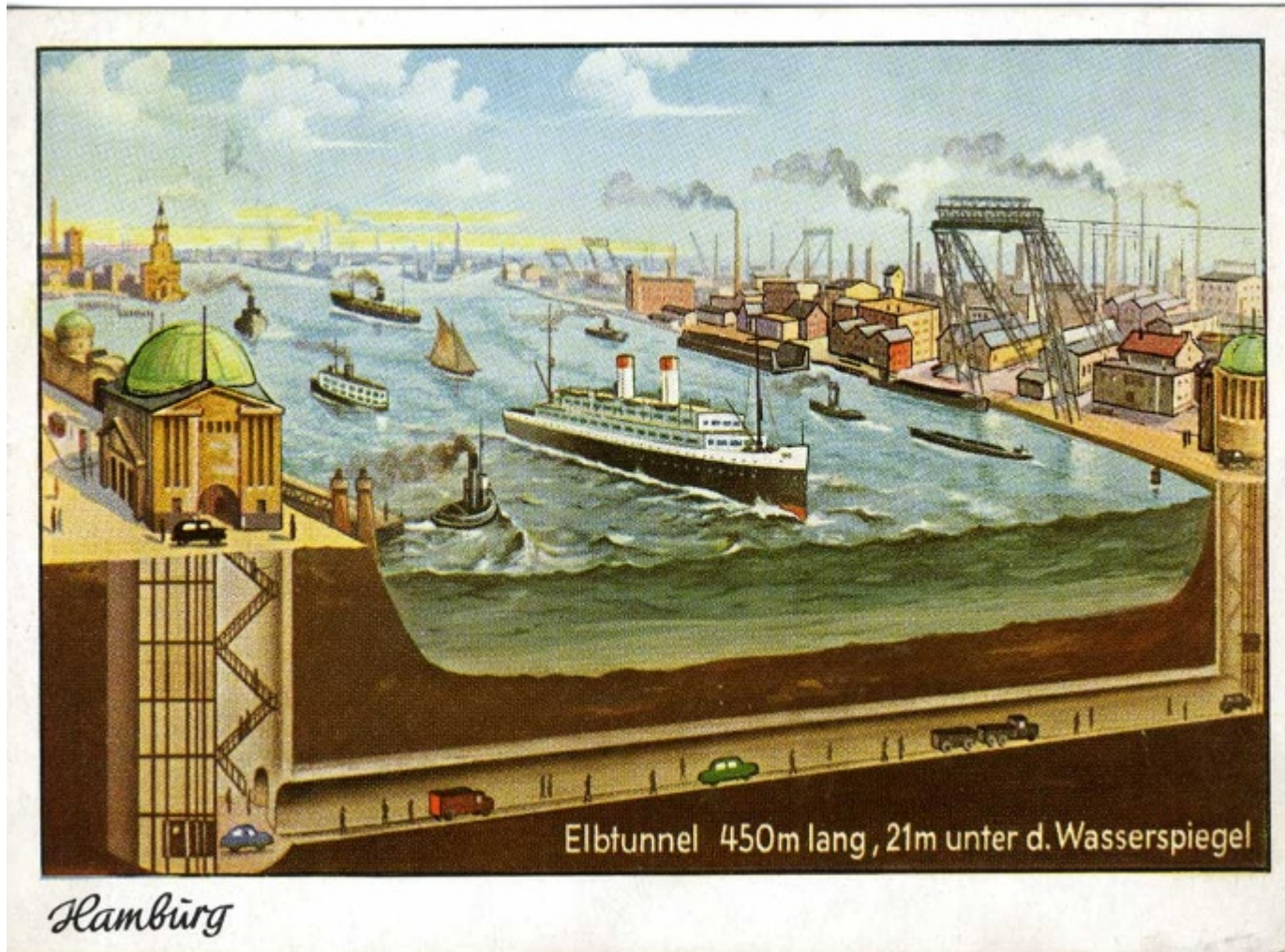

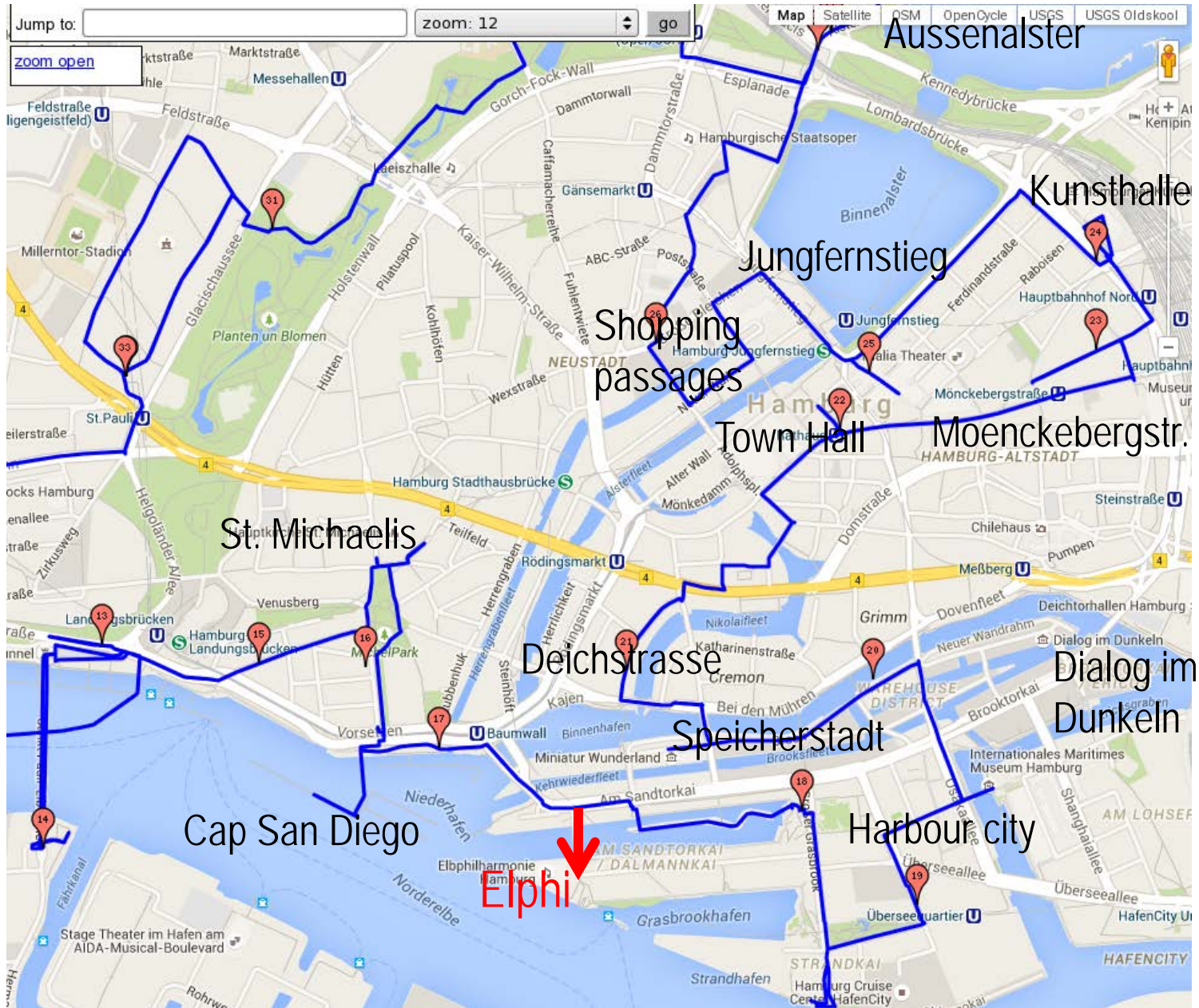


Hamburg Touristic Marathon

Walk through the old Elbtunnel from 1911 (no fee), impressive steel construction, take the stairs and walk through the tunnel, exit on other side and walk ~100 m to the river bank → nice panoramic view on Hamburg city

St. Michalis church – town's landmark, one of the 5 main churches in Hamburg
Climb the 132 m tall tower!! (Platform is at 106 m)

Krameramtsstuben, near to Michel, in a backyard, a large part of Hamburg looked like this before the big fire in 1842, cozy but also dark and very tight

Cargo museum ship in running conditions → a visit is really nice

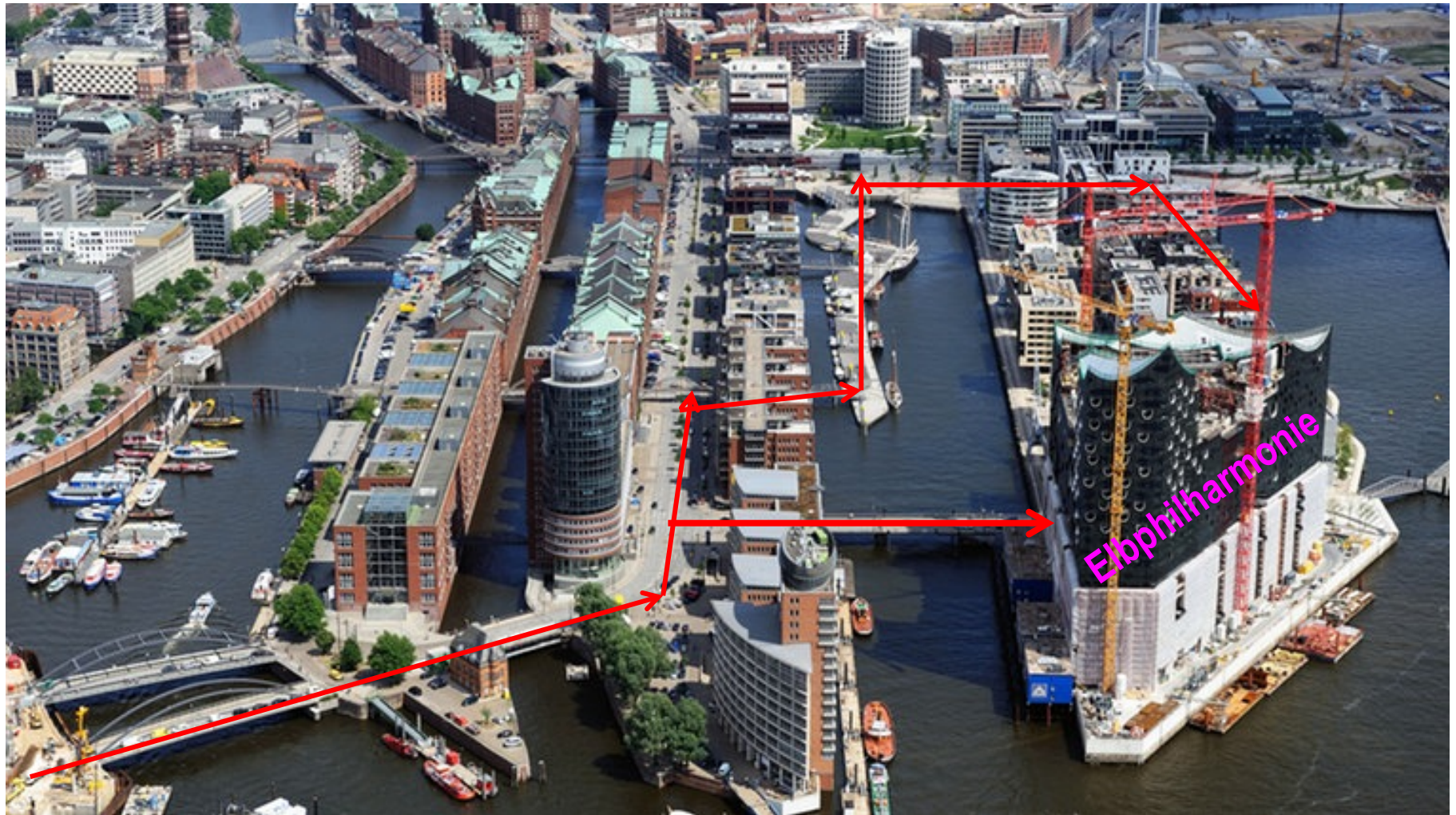

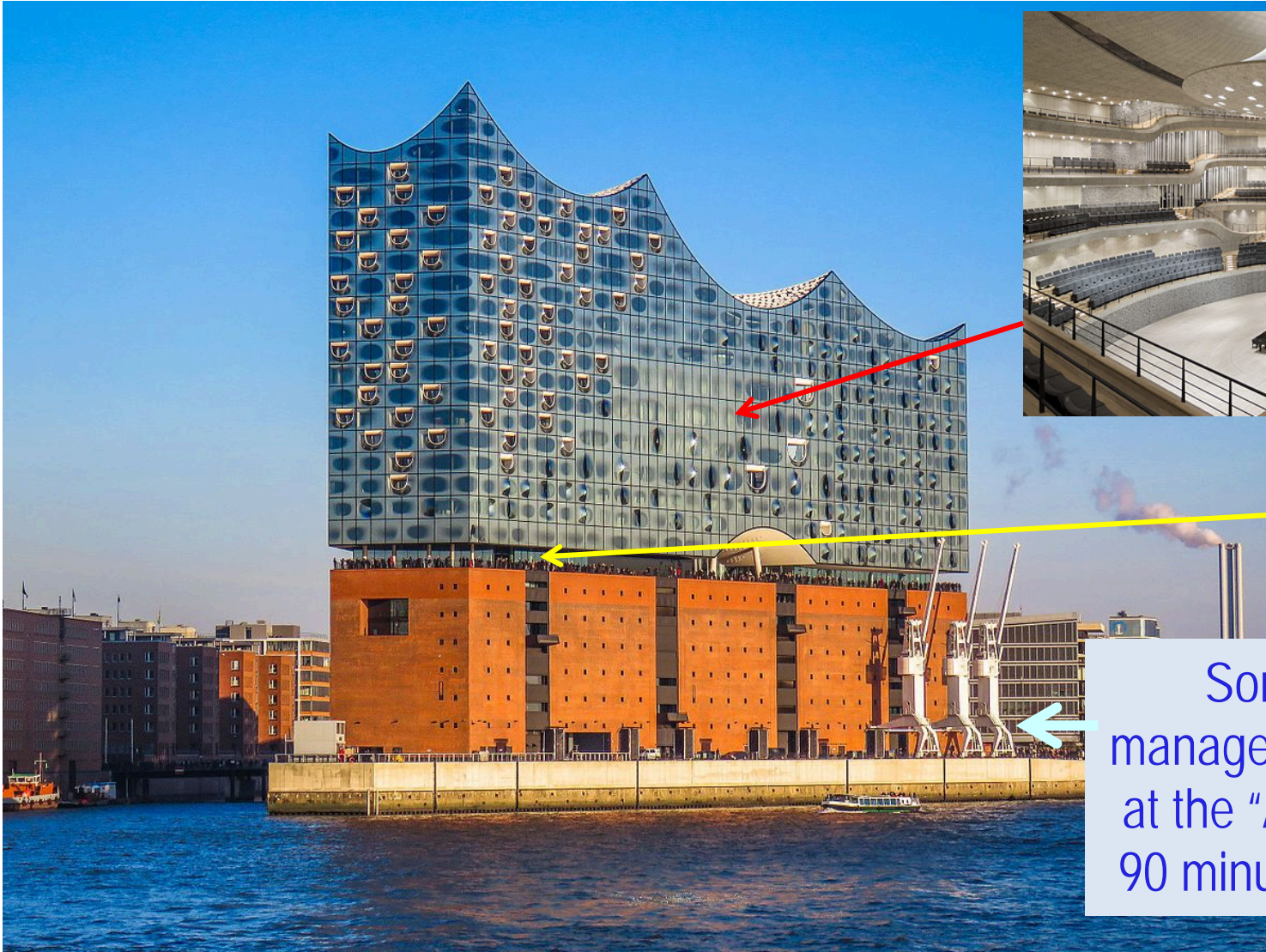

Hamburg Touristic Marathon

Speicherstadt:: built 1885-1927 (was) the largest warehouse district in the world



Hamburg Touristic Marathon

Speicherstadt:: built 1885-1927 (was) the largest warehouse district in the world



Elected in 2015 as a Unesco world heritage site (one of 40 in germany)

Magellan Terrassen – one of the first parts of the new Hafencity quarter

Maritime Museum in Hafencity (a visit is a bit expensive but worthwhile, e.g. you can toy with a real sextant)

Miniatur Wunderland : largest model railway in the world
and by far far far the biggest tourist attraction in Hamburg (based on #visitors)

Miniatur Wunderland : Check on their webpage the queue time or visit late in the evening



Hamburg Touristic Marathon

Deichstrasse, carefully restored 17th-19th century houses, nice "Kartoffelkeller" and other "Hamburg style" restaurants



Hamburg Touristic Marathon

St. Nikolai Church, destroyed in the bombing of Hamburg end of July 1943, Operation "Gomorrha", since then a memorial



147 m - Tallest building in the world from 1874-1877 😊

WW II destructions: Altona Grosse Bergstrasse

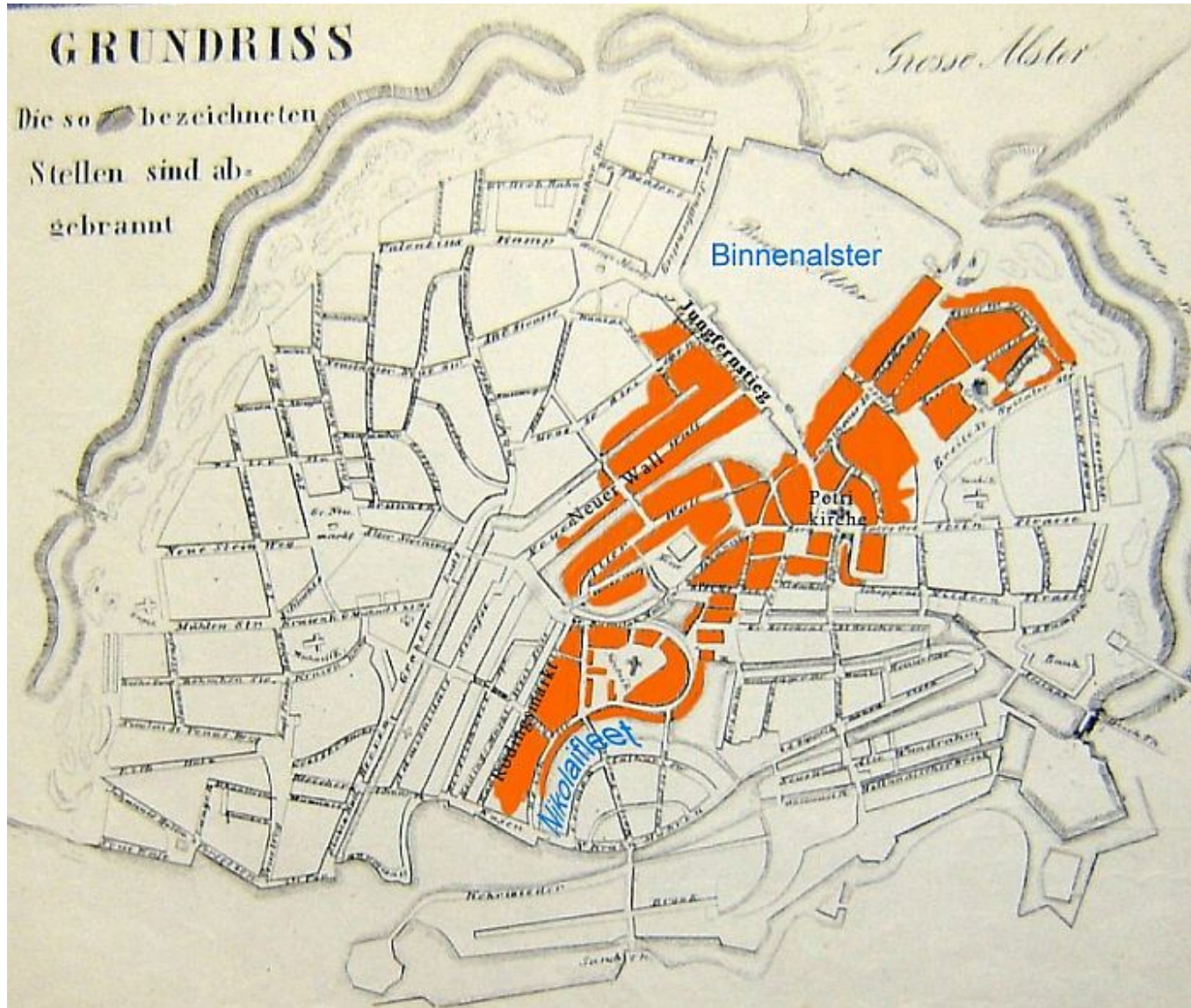

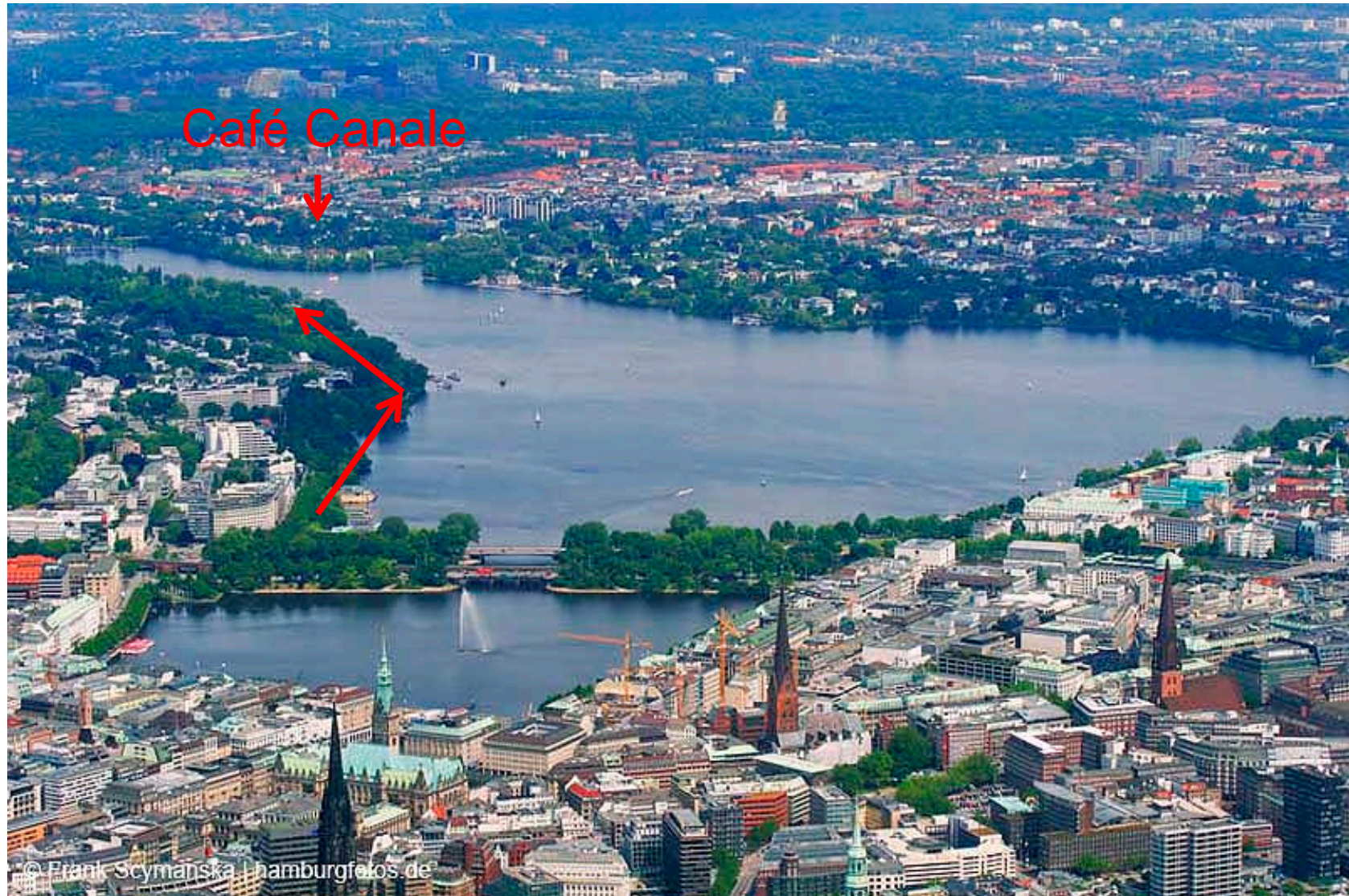

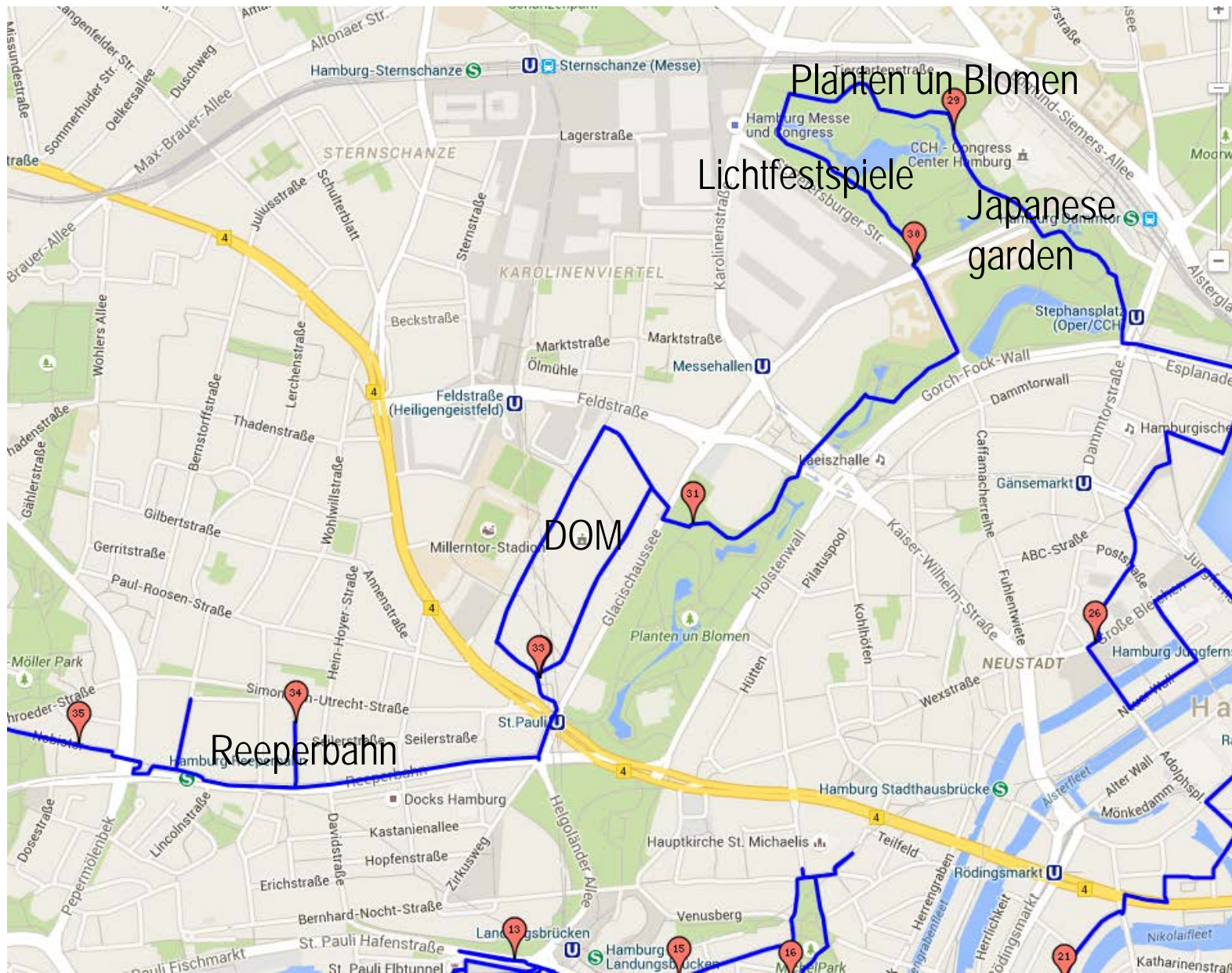

Reeperbahn - Grosse Freiheit, where the Beatles had their first gigs
Be cautious of rip-off joints along Reeperbahn street (the table dance bars with personal trying to pull you in) but otherwise many nice bars and clubs



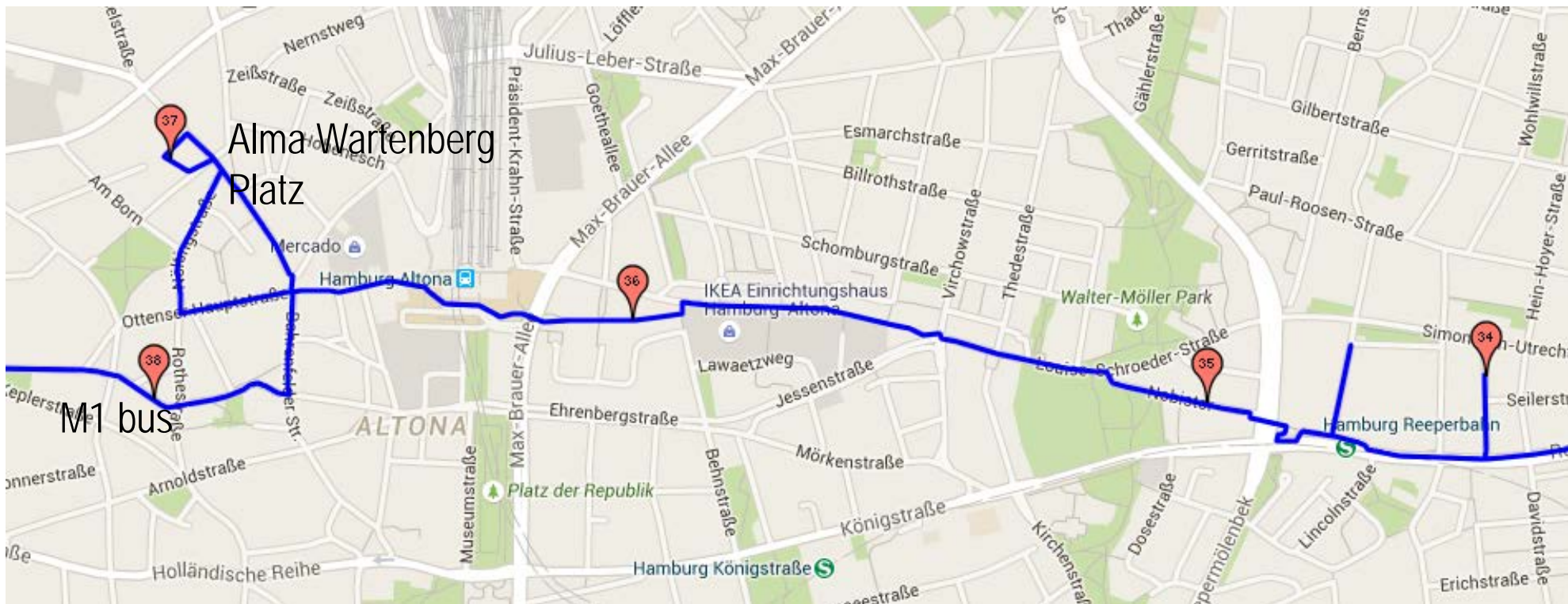
Hamburg Touristic Marathon

According to an old tradition you should at last once party on Reeperbahn/Grosse Freiheit through saturday night and then visit the famous Hamburg fishmarket (its ~500 m away) opening sunday at 5am

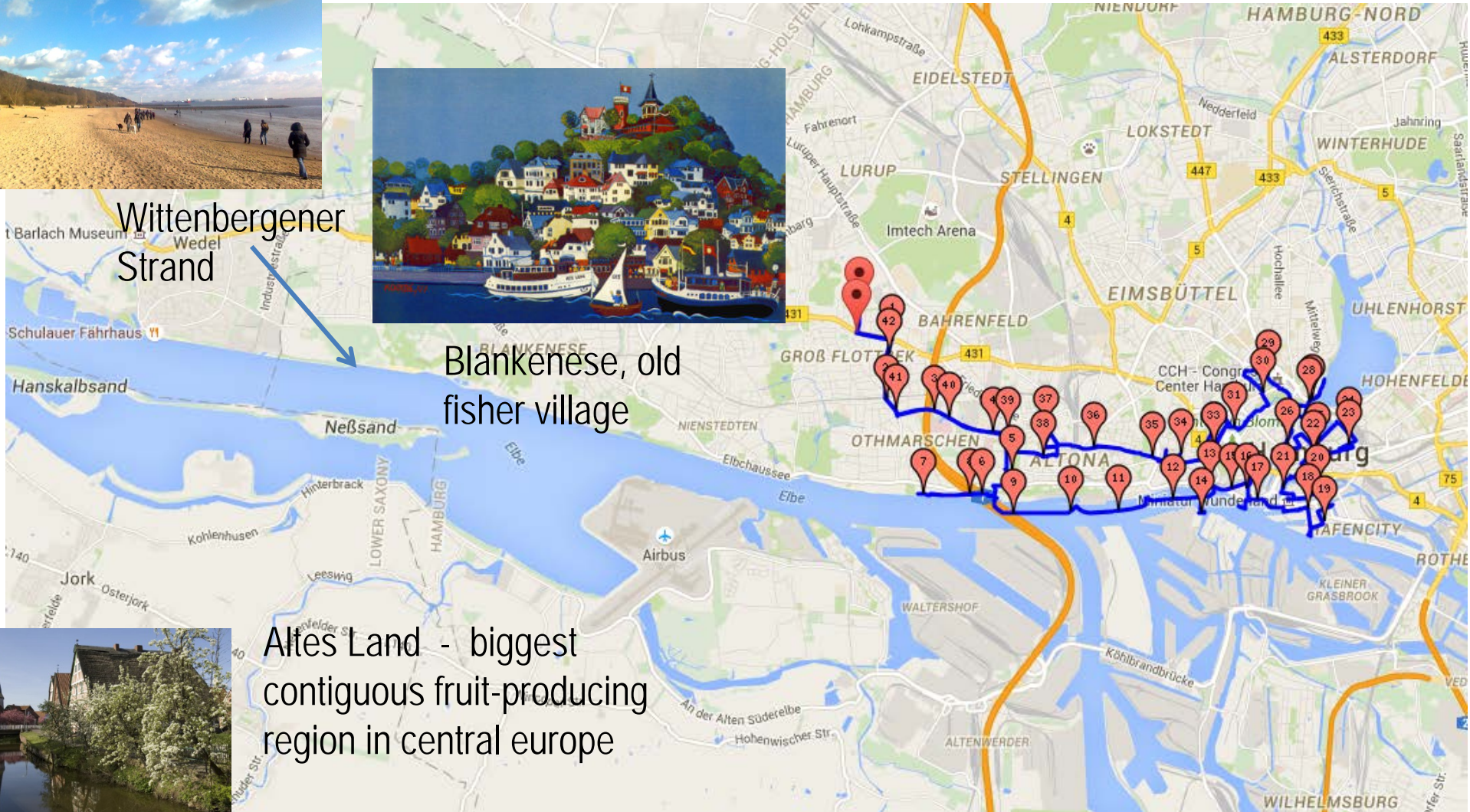

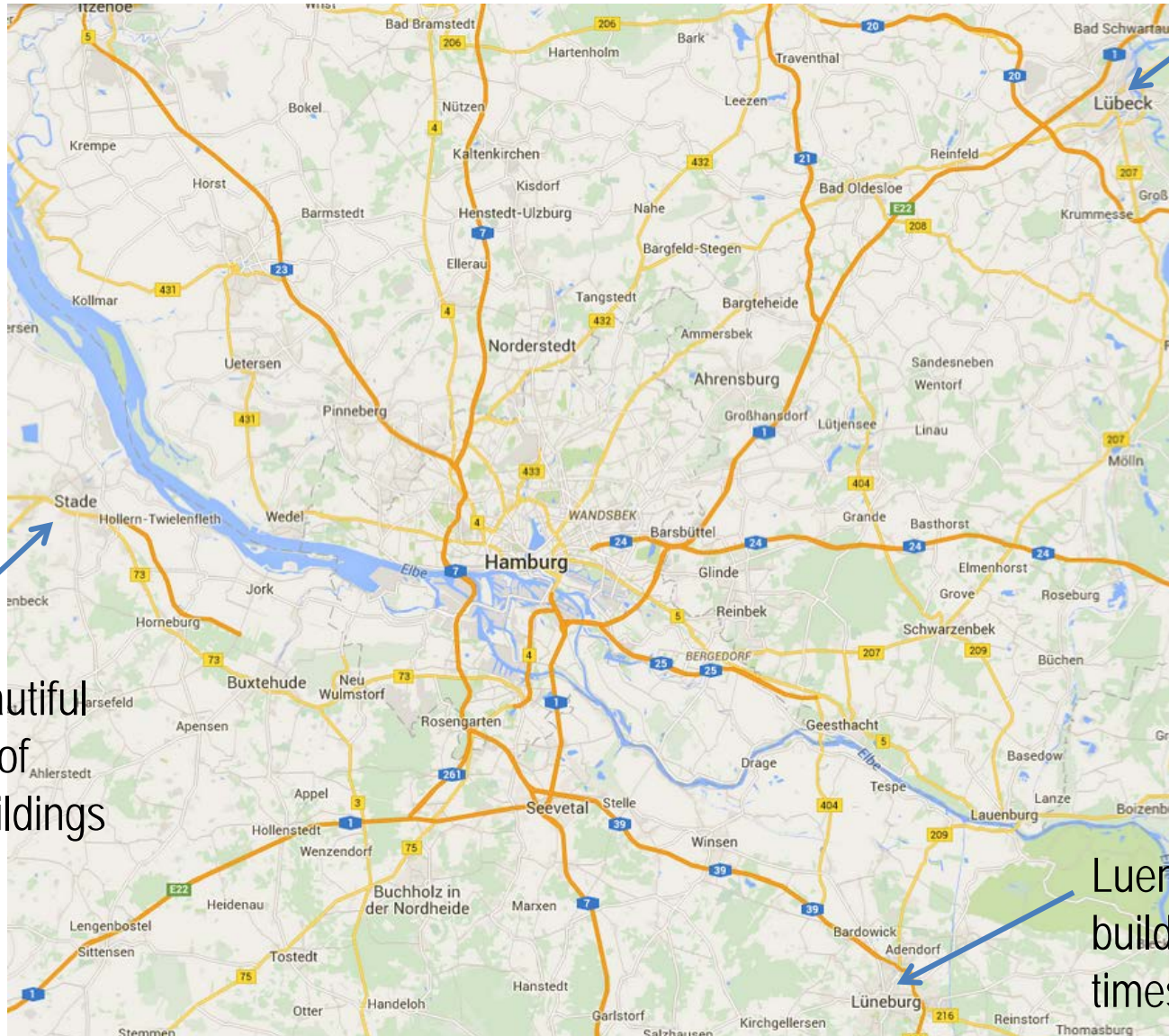


Altes Land - biggest contiguous fruit-producing region in central Europe

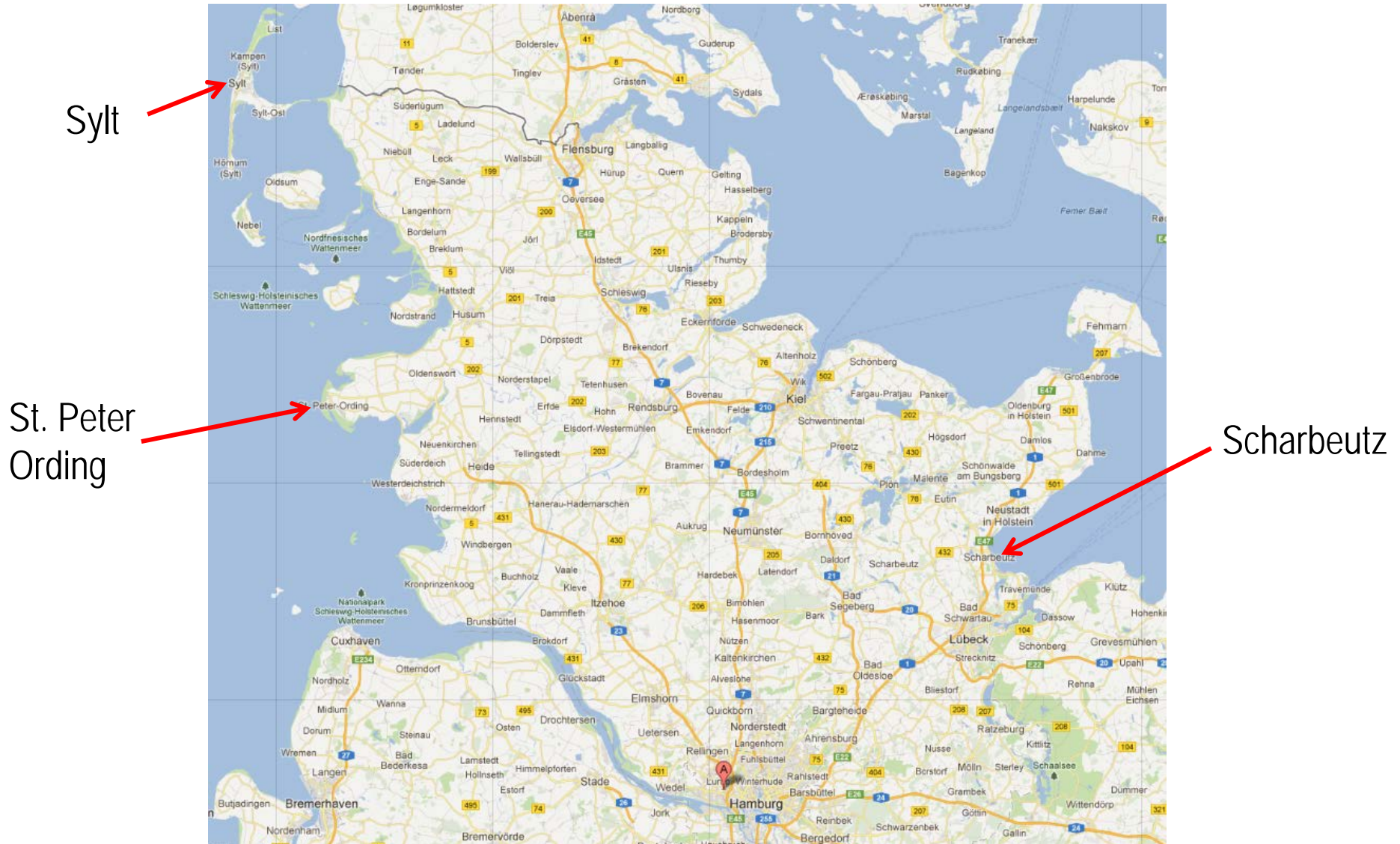
Lübeck, queen of the Hanse time, legendary

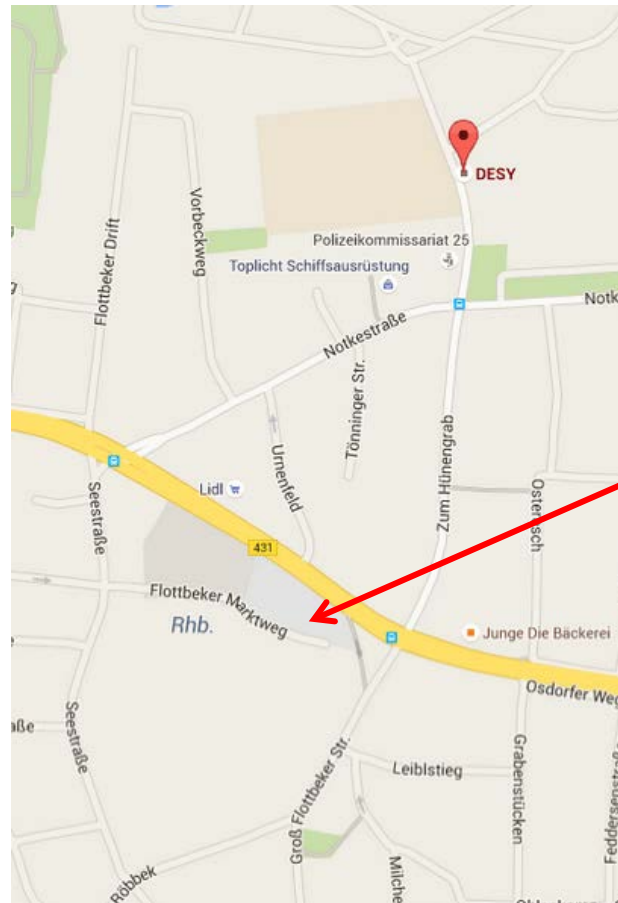
