### **ZEUS** papers / analyses

- H1+ZEUS: "Combination and QCD analysis of beauty and charm production cross section measurements in deep inelastic *ep* scattering at HERA", DESY-18-037, Eur. Phys. J. **C 78** (2018) 473.

### **H1+ZEUS** analyses

We will have an H1+ZEUS meeting on Wednesday at 14:00.

- No progress on QCD or W mass fits.
- Need to decide what to do about contact interactions analysis.
  - Basic ZEUS analysis is ready and we could start the paper procedure soon.
  - H1 analysis is being performed solely by Stefan Schmitt. Different method; EW and HFL effects; potential to look at other models and/or 2D fits.
  - We will see the results of both in the H1+ZEUS meeting and need to take a decision.
  - Possible options:
    - ▶ H1+ZEUS paper including 1D and 2D fits.
    - ▶ ZEUS paper on 1D fits (and H1+ZEUS paper on 2D fits).



## Parity violation in gravity paper draft

- On 8 August, Vahagn Gharibyan (Hermes and DESY-M) circulated a paper on "Evidence for parity violation in gravitational fields".
- The procedure for this paper was not good and the author has been informed.
- I have asked for all ZEUS authors to be removed, however people are of course free to choose.
- I have discussed with H1, Hermes and POL2000 group and all are sceptical but agree that we should not stop someone publishing a potentially big result.
- We have come up with a procedure for this to be checked/reviewed involving the collaborations, but not necessarily meaning that we commit to anything.
- I am not sure what the current status is it has gone quiet for a couple of weeks. There are probably discussions between the FH and M directors. I know e.g. Stefan Schmitt has done some cross-checks.
