






Public Transport: —/HVV

- > 9 am Day Ticket (9-Uhr-Tageskarte): €6.40, from 9 am to 6 am of the next day
- > 9 am Group Ticket (9-Uhr-Gruppenkarte): €12.20, as above, up to 5 people
- Can be purchased at stations, on the bus, or via HVV app (3% cheaper)
- Two bus stops close to DESY: Luruper
 Chaussee (closer to this building, blue route) and
 Zum Hünengrab (orange route)

Rent a bike: Hamburg StadtRAD

- > Registration fee (annual): €5
- > First 30 minutes of every trip: Free of charge
- > From 31st minute on: **€0.10** (max. **€**15)
- Can rent up to two bikes at the same time
- Bike lanes almost everywhere in the inner city and along the river Elbe

Speicherstadt, Elbphilharmonie and museums

- Warehouse district with characteristic red brick buildings that are directly on the river Elbe, very nice for a walk and not far from the city center
- > Even prettier at the sunset or with night lights
- > Various museums are in the area:
 - International Maritimes Museum €13 (€9.50 for students). Open from 10 am to 6 pm.
 - Miniatur Wunderland €15; queue is likely to take long, check website for expected duration at specific time. Open from 7:30 am to midnight.
 - Elbphilharmonie one can go up for free and admire Hamburg from above. No concerts in this period.



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Walk through the city center and around lake Alster



- Have a boat trip from Jungfernstieg on the Alster lake
- Rent a boat, canoe or kayak, or cycle around the lake and relax in a park
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- Visit the Hamburg Rathaus (City Hall)
- Do some shopping and have an ice cream looking at the Alster fountain
- > Visit the Hamburger Kunsthalle (art museum): open from 10 a.m. to 18 p.m. Tickets for €14 (€8 for students)



River Elbe and boat tours from Landungsbrücken

If the weather is nice, it can also be nice to enjoy what the river Elbe has to offer, like

- > Lay on the beach: Elbstrand
 - I personally wouldn't suggest to have a swim in the river
- Take a ferry from Landungsbrücken, from there various lines depart in different directions
 - The tickets are the same used for bus and metro

Have a walk and then a beer

- Sternchanze: perfect to spend the evening. Many places to eat and drink. (Suggestion: Ratsherrn/Altes Mädchen, brewery and restaurant)
- St. Pauli: along Reeperbahn (Hamburg's red lights district) also many places to eat and drink, usually more messy and crowded. Astra brewery is here, most popular beer in Hamburg (doesn't mean the best)
- Ottensen: closer to DESY, many pubs and restaurants in Bahrenfelder Straße or neighbouring streets. Many people have beers outside in Alma-Wartenberg-Platz
