Ensuring good scientific practice at DESY Motivation

- Amendment to the DFG rules to ensure good scientific practice: "Guidelines for ensuring good scientific practice" of the German Research Foundation (DFG) active since August 01, 2019.
- Require implementation of the new DFG regulations by July 31, 2021 in order to be eligible for funding from the DFG

=> Tasks:

- Update of the current rules to ensure good scientific practice at DESY
- Establishment of a commission for the investigation of scientific misconduct, called at DESY: commission for securing good scientific practice at DESY
