Aim

Format of survey

Additionally, we are offering online sessions (via Zoom) in case you have questions regarding the survey (if for instance something is not clear, you are not sure how to answer etc.) or if you have some extra points you would like to share or discuss with us directly.

Target group

This survey primarily targets work package leaders and co-leaders of the technical work packages (WP2-WP7) of CREMLINplus as well as project participants who have experience with science collaboration with partners in Russia. Further, external experts, with extensive knowledge and experience in science management, including decision makers on a political level, can participate.

Context

This survey is prepared by the CREMLINplus WP10 LTS Team from NRC KI and DESY (Work Package 10 Joint long-term sustainability of RIs) as part of the Task 10.1 «Promote Synergy». The data will be collected and analysed by the WP10 LTS Team. The results will be presented and discussed within the CREMLINplus community in a workshop, with the aim to jointly develop suggestions and recommendations to overcome or to reduce related problems and obstacles.

Note: Requirements of long-term sustainability (LTS) of RIs are the successful construction, launch, operation of RIs, as well as reaching scientific goals. LTS of RIs encompasses areas such as funding and governance aspects, socio-economic impact, the management and exploitation of data and the innovation potential as well as training and education, skills, and knowledge exchange.

- Under Task 10.2 «Link Russian Megascience projects to EU strategic initiatives» (ESFRI, LENS, LEAPS) DESY and NRC KI addressed the representatives of the ESFRI forum with the aim to consider the possibility of establishing closer ties with the PIK ICNR project. Several virtual events within LENS and LEAPS community are scheduled for 2021. These events are considered as a good opportunity to present Russian Megascience projects, e.g. PIK ICNR Project to the LENS community.

- Analysis of results of questionnaire developed under Task 10.1 “Promote synergy” will allow to plan and schedule events that will be of interest for the whole CREMLINplus community.
- For the next year it is planned to continue the work under Task 10.2 which includes a closer cooperation with LENS and LEAPS representatives and to organize side event related to Task 10.1. “Promote synergy”.
- Despite the fact that the upcoming event on Science Diplomacy has been postponed until the moment when it can be held face-to-face, its organization will require the start of work already this year.
