Midterm Evaluation 2009

During 2009 (preparation for midterm evaluation):

Alliance has developed a first idea about the time after 2012:
Perspektivbericht 2009, which has been submitted to Helmholtz
as part of the midterm evaluation

- First structural ideas
- Feedback from the partners (letters from 17 universities concerning a possible continuation after 2012)

Results from the evaluation:

Committee urges Helmholtz to find ways to continue the Alliance funding after 2012

Helmholtz internal

Review of DESY program in 2009 (POF review)

Committee is impressed by the achievements of the Alliance. DESY (Helmholtz) is charged to develop a strategy and a proposal for a continuation of the Alliance structures for the time after 2012 and deliver this to Mlynek by end 2011.

Result of the POF evaluation:

As part of the DESY budget for 2010-2015 DESY gets granted 1 Mio / year to sustain part of the DESY activities (essentially the tenured positions)

Activities 2010

Spring 2010: discussion with Mlynek on the future of the Alliance

- Basis is Perspektivpapier
- Stress the role of the Alliance in connecting Helmholtz with the universities

- In general positive feedback from Mlynek
- Main problem: where can the money come from

- Agreement with Mlynek: work out a more concrete proposal from the Alliance by early 2011, discuss possible funding schemes

Insertion: Helmholtz funding

Particle physics is part of Structure of matter (SdM) in Helmholtz

SdM gets +1.4% / year for 2010 - 2015

2010: PAKTII is agreed on: research gets a special boost,
additional money → Helmholtz gets instead of +2% +5%/ year

The good news: there is fresh, unassigned money in the system

The bad news: the competition for this new money is fierce.

Helmholtz Politics

Money from PAKTII:

Initiate Portfolio process for new initiatives and ideas

This is a top-down approach, by which Helmholtz identifies areas where they want to be more active,

then calls for proposals to install concrete projects in these areas .

What we (DESY/ Alliance management) try to do:

Inject our proposal (Alliance like structures after 2012) into this process

Goal: establish this as a theme within the portfolio process

We can make a proposal only if we are successful in this!

How to proceed

The Helmholtz situation is very dynamic and changing fast: we try to adapt to this as flexibly as possible

We hope that we will have a chance to submit a concrete proposal in 2011

We should prepare for this regardless of feedback from Helmholtz

- Have a brainstorming meeting among group leaders of all partners early in 2011 (“Frankfurt” meetings from the startup times of the Alliance)
 - Proposal Jan 28 (Friday) in Frankfurt

- Start a serious discussions in the boards on content of a possible post-alliance structure:

Propose to boards that they organize dedicated meetings in the first few month of 2011 to do this.

Problem: deadline/ time scales are not clear and change fast
