- 18 autonomous Helmholtz centres
- Each sends 2 members
- HGF is the largest non-university scientific organization in Germany
- The HeJus represent around 8500 DRs






What do we do ?

The network of networks

- Cooperation of the Helmholtz Juniors, PhDnet (Max-Planck), PhD Network (Leibniz) and IPP Mainz
 - Together representing over 16 000 DRs
 - Gaining political power !
- Goals
 - 30 days of holidays
 - 100 % payment
 - 4 year contract duration
 - Abolishment of stipends
 - Prevention of power abuse



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
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
Last survey: 15.10.2021 – 23.11.2021

- 17 of the 18 possible centers
- Total participants: 2143
- ~39% of all DRs (according to Fortschrittsbericht 2020)
- The data provides:

- Assessment of status quo of DRs in nonuniversity research organizations
- Assess latent issues
- Identify areas of improvement
- Basis for HeJu work in the next 2 years !
