Group Management in the new Registry (R2)

Registry 2

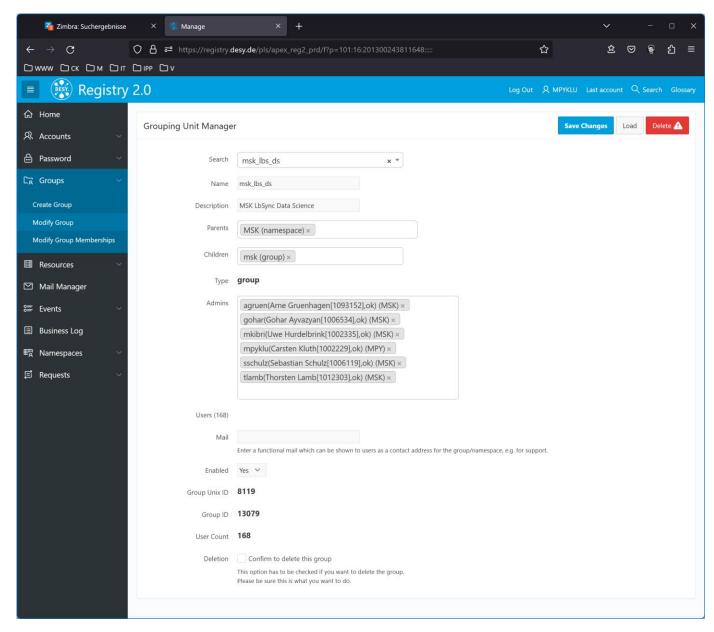
- management of accounts, passwords, groups, ressources, namespaces
- management of personal data → IAM
- relationship between IAM persons and their R2 accounts
- R2 namespace
 - typically an institute or a DESY group, e.g. EMBL or MPY
- R2 account types
 - primary (always first account of a person)
 - personal (additional account of a person)
 - functional (shared account / password, e.g. to store dCache data, no expiration date possible)
 - service (for important services, e.g. machine controls)
- R2 ressource
 - to grant access to e.g. Mail, Sync&Share, Linux, Windows, Maxwell (partitions), NAF...
 - no ressource dCache

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Registry 2

- R2 group
 - list of accounts
 - belongs to a namespace
 - propagation to platforms like dCache, Sync&Share, Unix, Windows...
 - groups may include other groups(!), e.g. all members of a R2 group + some additional accounts (configuration via DESY IT only)
- R2 roles
 - typically namespace supervisors, namespace admins, group admins
 - most IT group administrators are namespace supervisors and namespace admins
 - IT group administrators are able to create and manage R2 groups incl. designation of group admins
