1st -2nd February 2024





WLAN Guest Networks

WLAN eduroam

For guests, whose home institutes are participating in the project eduroam, DESY offers this wireless guest network connection. For registered user this is a quick and easy way to obtain a secure access to the Internet without any further registration.

WLAN Science-Hotspot

This guest WLAN does not require user registration. Users only have to accept the usage regulations on the portal website of the WLAN network.

On the left there should then be a menu item "My Contributions" under "My Conference". Clicking on this and then on the name of your presentation and finally on the pencil on the right of "Presentation material" will allow you to upload slides from your local computer. If you do not have an Indico account yet, you might be able to use Helmholtz AAI via your institute to log in to Indico (you can choose that as an option from the Indico Login page) and proceed as above. In case neither of these options does work for you, please bring your presentation on a USB stick and contact one of the organisers/chairs of your session, preferably beforehand. In addition, you could send us your presentation via email.

Registration at DESY

The main time for on-site registration is before the first plenary on Thursday from 9:00 to 9:30 am at the help desk in the foyer of the main auditorium of DESY. At the desk, you can also pick up a travel form. Please remember to sign the attendance sheet every day.

Food

We offer coffee breaks during the plenary and parallel sessions of the meetings in the foyer of the auditorium and in front of the seminar rooms. Lunch/Dinner is self-organised and not part of the meeting. The <u>DESY canteen</u> and cafeteria service in building 9 are currently moved due to renovation.
