Latest updates: postdoc mentoring



- Possibility for postdocs to access additional guidance
- Help in making a plan at the start of the contract (after choosing the group/subgroup to join)
- Mentor initially assigned by FH director in agreement with group leader
- The postdoc can then select a new mentor (or keep the one assigned) after 1 year so they have time to get to know the DESY staff
- All done in conjunction with a more precise definition of a postdoc supervisor tasks (the staff member who is the primary contact for the postdoc)
- Should become official sometime this year, some trial implementations are starting already
- The ECSB was consulted on the definition of the roles, goals, and mechanism to select the mentor



Latest updates: D&I



- ECSB met with the Diversity and Inclusion officer
- Some of us attend the diversity round table meetings and offer support
- Discussion on bilingualism at DESY:

- We were also contacted to review the draft of the Diversity Survey you might have heard about during the Diversity Day





Latest updates: DESY psychologist




- Initial mismatch between her mandate and expectations from scientists
 - Round of introduction across FH groups interrupted
 - large differences in stress factors between scientists and other DESY employees
- ECSB + QU PhD/postdoc councils met with the DESY psychologist → clarified her mandate and competences
 - Mental health first aid
 - > Contact for crisis situation: burnout, conflict situations, sexual harassment
 - No legal obligation to report what is said during meetings
 - > Support people getting back to work after long absences (sick leave, accidents, parental leave, ...)
 - Automatic message for absence > 6 weeks
 - Support on conflict management
 - Helps organizing workshops on mental health (currently low attendance from scientists)
 - > Can help organizing dedicated mental health retreats for groups upon request




Latest updates: other topics



- Survey on colloquium attendance:
 - > Results shown to Beate and taskforce, report sent to taskforce
 - > Main takeaways:
 - General appreciation for quality of speakers and topics
 - Mostly seen and valued as working time
 - Rather large variance of opinions on time slot
- Working hour tracking:
 - > Currently not for scientists → actions taken by DESY and other Universities to keep it that way
- Facilitate contact with FH director:
 - > Beate has shown interest in having more events with FH PhDs and postdocs
 - → we are available to help

Final remarks




- ECSB contacted by taskforces to hear from young scientists several times
