

Getting to University of Limerick: Getting to UL | University of Limerick

The University of Limerick (UL) is located in Castletroy, approximately 3km from Limerick City Centre.

Airports in Ireland



Getting from Limerick city to UL:

Limerick is accessible from all Irish airports, but we recommend Shannon Airport as it is close to UL and is small airport so is easy and quick to get through. There are also ferries from the UK, France and Spain to Dublin, Cork and Rosslare ports.

Bus services connect Limerick City to UL, routes 304, 304A and 310. There are two bus stops in the University, one inside the Main Entrance (closest to the Castletroy Park Hotel) and the second outside the University of Limerick Stables Club/ UL Student Life (centre of campus).

Shannon Airport is located 24km from Limerick City and is well-serviced by Bus and Taxi Services.

There are a number of bus services which connect Shannon Airport to Limerick City, including Route 51 and Route 343, with a drop-off point located at Limerick Bus and Train Station (Colbert Station) or William Street in Limerick city centre. Bus routes 304, 304A and 310 connect Limerick city to UL,

Alternatively, there is an airport cab and taxi desk located in the Arrivals Hall. The average cost is approximately €50-€70.

Dublin Airport and Cork airports: There are several coach operators who offer fast and efficient services from Dublin and Cork Airports. For current pricing and timetables:

Flight link: Route 723 <u>Timetable Home - Flight Link</u> offers a direct service from Dublin Airport to Castletroy. Route The bus stop is approximately a 20-minute walk from the University of Limerick Campus.

Citylink: Routes 712X and 712 offer a direct service from Dublin Airport to Castletroy. Route The bus stop is approximately a 15-minute walk from the University of Limerick Campus.

Citylink: Route <u>251</u> offers a service from Cork Airport to Limerick City Centre, where you can either change onto a local bus or take a taxi to the University campus.

Dublin Coach: Offers a service from Dublin airport to the University of Limerick campus, Stables Club) with one change at the Red Cow Luas interchange in Dublin N7 Service - Dublin Coach (airport to Red Cow) and M7 Express Service - Dublin Coach (Red Cow to UL).

Castletroy Park Hotel: The Castletroy Park Hotel | Hotels in Limerick | 4 Star Hotels Limerick

The Castletroy Park Hotel is located just across the road from the UL Flagpoles entrance, Eircode V94 YOAN and is a 10-minute walk to the centre of UL campus. Bus <u>304A</u> from Limerick City centre stops here just inside the UL flagpoles.

The hotel has reserved a maximum of 20 bedrooms for GENERA for September 3rd/4th/5th at the UL rate of €114 bed & breakfast single occupancy per night, in a mixture of bedrooms & suites. The group reservation reference number is #581995 so you can book directly with the hotel. Please note the release date for any rooms not booked is 8 weeks prior to the arrival date.
