1.) Storage Planning for 2012

- * Disk crisis due to flooding in Asia is hitting the market
- RWTH got large investment before
- DESY bought disk in December on "old"(=acceptable) conditions
- * New capacity in RWTH expected to be fully commissioned by February
- Details on mirroring of /store/user being discussed
- * Almost 475TB additional brutto capacity available at DESY
 - Gives about 100TB for user (mirrored) and 275TB for data/mc
 - Commissioning in February (or when needed)
 - Further storage procurement planned in 2012

(like in 2nd half of 2012, disk price might relax by then)

- * NAF uses different DN to "NAF user name" mapping (HN name not always NAF login)
 - Source of mapping to be provided by DESY

 - SONAS (IBM product based on GPFS) successor of Lustre
 - Hardware installed and being configured by IBM service staff
 - First mounts on the NAF for testing expected for February
