Foundation process and goals

Starting point – a gut feeling

Prior to KET15 elections:

- No young scientist (YS) member of KET [1]
 - → are we adequately represented?
- At the time, no 'lobby' for YS (however, student and PhD associations at university/institute level, 'junge DPG', ...)
 - → no coordination, no mandate
 - → little communication amongst YS
- Little communication b/w KET and YS
 - → likely both parties seek improvement
- Little 'training' of YS in management tasks in HEP
 - → room for improvement in 'talent fostering'



Try to start self-organisation process

Problem: How to contact a group of people w/o knowledge of their email addresses?

Efforts

After discussions at KET annual meeting 15:

- Started @ 'DPG Tagung' in HH with help from K. Desch: announcement via DPG lists, evening meeting
 - → Gathered ~15 YS
 - → Ch. Zeitnitz presented KET + Q&A
 - → Decision to follow up this effort
- Contacted KET, KAT, KfB, KHuK (= HEP):
 - → Asked to send my call via their lists
 - → ~220 members subscribed to our list, mostly KET/KAT
- Regular online meetings
- Decision on name:

young high-energy physicists (yHEP) association

young = fixed-term contract (no age discrimination)

Efforts II

- Compilation of 'Charter of the yHEP association' [2]
 - → Acceptance of Charter on Sep 25th
- Charter included creation of management board that represents the association
- Election period from 4.11. 15.11.16
 - → Management board in place
- Deploy e-vote system by election supervisors:
 - no ballot slips to be sent
 - secret and fair
 - tool of choice also for future polls
- Started website: yhep.desy.de
- Started creation of a logo

Short term goals

- Consolidate visibility of the yHEP association
 - → new post-docs/students shall always be informed
- Create appreciation for our process and goals
- Upcoming survey: situation of members, field of research in yHEP, reasons for Ph.D./post-doc? industry vs. research? ...
- Create incentives for feedback from members
- Organise a general assembly (offline + online)



Intermediate and long-term goals

- Create partnerships, maybe with graduate schools?
- Try to acquire some funding for organisation of events/workshops
- Enable a direct communication channel between the section committees and the yHEP association.
- Participate actively and sustained at committee meetings
- Discuss the role of YS in science, science outreach and teaching
- Find strategies of support for YS where improvement is needed
